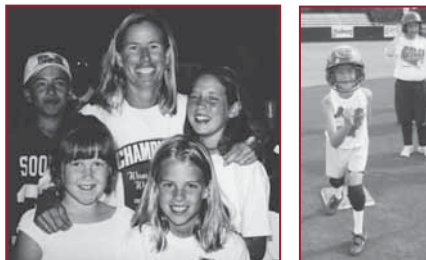

## COACHING STAFF

### Head Coach *Patty Gasso*

16<sup>th</sup> Season, Long Beach State, 1984



As she begins her 16th season at the University of Oklahoma, head coach Patty Gasso has molded the OU softball program into a national power and permanently placed herself among the elite college softball coaches in the country.

The Sooners reached the Women's College World Series in 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003 and 2004, and have advanced to the postseason every season she has been in Norman. The WCWS run began in 2000 when her team won the NCAA National Championship in OU's first appearance.

Currently in her 20th season as a head coach, Gasso has a career collegiate coaching record of 861-286-2 (.749) and holds an overall record of 699-227-2 (.753) at the University of Oklahoma. She has won more Big 12 games (184-61) than any coach in the league's history and has twice as many wins as any other coach in OU history. Gasso's Sooner teams have finished second or higher 11 different times since the inception of the Big 12 in 1996. They have won 75 percent of their Big 12 contests and OU has claimed three Big 12 regular season and three tournament titles under her direction.

Numerous Sooner players have prospered under Gasso's tutelage and garnered national, regional and conference recognition. She has directed 30 All-Americans, 55 All-Midwest Region honorees and 94 all-conference selections.

### Associate Head Coach *Melissa Lombardi*

13th Season, University of Oklahoma, 1997



As a catcher for Oklahoma in 1995-1996, Melissa Lombardi helped direct the Sooner pitchers to new heights. Now in her 13th season as a full-time assistant coach, Lombardi continues to guide the Sooner pitchers and catchers to even greater accomplishments.

Lombardi was promoted to Associate Head Coach in July of 2007 after assisting the Sooners to a 55-8 overall record during the 2007 season and developing OU's first Big 12 Pitcher of the Year. Lauren Eckermann also earned All-America honors and tied the school record for most wins in a season with 37.

Drawing from her playing days as a catcher for the Sooners, Lombardi has been able to lend her valuable experiences in tutoring the Oklahoma catchers and pitchers. During Lombardi's tenure, the Sooners won the 2000 National Championship and have won seven NCAA Regional Championships in 10 postseason appearances. In addition the Sooners have claimed two Big 12 regular season titles (1999, 2000) and two conference tournament championships (2001, 2007).

A former all-conference catcher for the Sooners, Lombardi has also coached the Oklahoma battery to a combined 10 All-America honors, 16 All-Region accolades and 23 All-Big 12 selections during her time in Norman.

### Assistant Coach *Tripp MacKay*

3rd Season, Oklahoma State, 2000



Tripp MacKay begins his third season as an assistant on the Oklahoma softball staff where he is responsible for working with OU's outfielders and the Sooner offense. In his first season with the program, MacKay helped lead Amber Flores to All-America honors and coached some of the nation's most prolific hitters in Flores, Samantha Ricketts, Lindsey Vandever and Savannah Long.

MacKay is a familiar name in the state of Oklahoma as he began his collegiate career at the University of Florida and played his final two seasons at Oklahoma State. He was a two-time All-American and a member of the 1996 College World Series squad at Oklahoma State. MacKay graduated with a degree in physical education from OSU in 2000.

MacKay began his coaching career with valuable experience at the collegiate level as an assistant coach. He made stops at Blinn College, Palm Beach Community College and Northeast Texas Community College from 1997-2000.

He spent the next seven years as a private hitting instructor in Dallas and, in 2004, became a partner of the Dallas Performance Edge Training Center. MacKay was instrumental in all aspects of the softball side of the academy including pitching, hitting, fielding, catching, base running and position specific skills.

### Returned Check Policy

If a check that was used to pay a camper's registration fee is returned, the involved sport's camp administrator shall attempt to contact the account holder to collect payment. If the full cost of attendance has not been received within 60 days of the check being returned, the camp administrator will turn over the delinquent account to a collection agency or the District Attorney's Office. **\*\*All returned checks are subject to an additional \$20 fee.**

**Out of state campers** - Please contact Kaycee Clark before you make airline reservations.

**Housing & Food** -You will live on the University of Oklahoma campus in University Housing under the supervision of camp staff. All meals will be provided at a University cafeteria under the direction of a licensed dietitian. The campers will be housed in an air-conditioned university residence hall with roomates of equivalent age or position or by request. Each room has two beds. Two rooms are joined by a bathroom to form a "suite".

Roommate requests will only be accepted for Advanced Camp until May 29<sup>th</sup> and for Sooner Camp until June 5<sup>th</sup>. The requested roommate must also complete the registration form and pay in full by May 29<sup>th</sup> for Advanced Camp and June 5<sup>th</sup> for Sooner Camp. **We can no longer guarantee suitemate requests.**

**Insurance** - Will be covered by Coaches' Choice, a very comprehensive camp insurance program, consisting of the following coverages: **Accident-Medical-General Liability, and Lifetime Catastrophic. Note: A \$50 deductible is charged to any individual involved with a claim.**

### Cancellations

- In case of medical emergency, a **\$100 administration fee** will be assessed. A doctor's letter must accompany any request for a medical refund.
- In case of cancellation, a **\$100 administration fee** will be assessed. There will be no refunds for cancellations which occur within 2 weeks prior to the first day of camp.
- There will be no refunds to anyone who leaves during the week of camp.

**Disipline** - The camp director reserves the right to dismiss anyone for any violations during camp. Tuition will not be refunded for any voluntary withdrawal or expulsion from Patty Gasso's Sooner Softball Camp.
